














### Holidays

#### UK TRAFFIC-LIGHT SYSTEM

-  One test within 72 hours of departure to the UK
  -  PCR test on or before the second day after landing in UK
  -  No quarantine requirement
  -  Test within 72 hours of departure to the UK
  -  Quarantine at home for at least 10 days
  -  PCR tests on day two and eight of quarantine
  -  Eligible for early release by paying for extra test on day five
  -  Quarantine in an approved hotel for 11 days at a cost of £1,750 per person
  -  Pre-departure test followed by tests on day two and day eight
  -  No direct flights between UK and red-list countries
  -  UK nationals fly home via third country

The overall winner was **RED** - great team work!

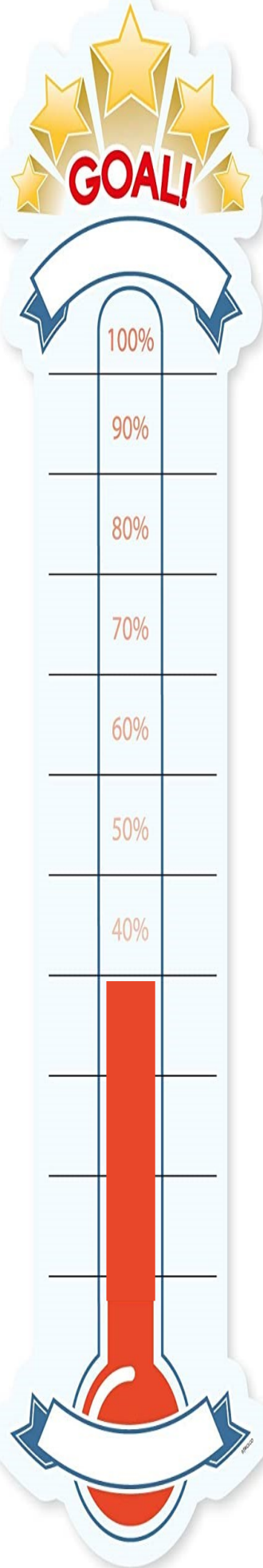
