
Dear Parents, Carers and pupils,

School Vision

What does this mean?

When you see us working around the school, we will be able to talk about the skills and knowledge we are learning around a subject. It also means that the staff have high expectations of us with regards to behaviour. These expectations range from always being in and on time, to always being in the correct uniform and always being ready and willing to learn.

Each of curriculum areas are based around Ofsted's 3 i's: Intent, Implementation and Impact. Each curriculum statement can be found on our school website and around the school on displays.

Intent What does this mean?

This shows us what we want from our curriculum.

Implementation What does this mean?

This shows how we want lessons and learning to look and why we have topics in each year group. We also focus on the progression of skills for each subject.

Impact What does this mean?

We measure the progression of your knowledge and make sure we focus on and if each year group is achieving the outcomes.

At Hillsgrove we use the 5 r's of LIFE LONG LEARNING approach to our learning.

What does this mean?

Resilience: to be able to recover quickly from difficulties

Resourcefulness: to be able to find quick and clever ways to solve challenges

Reflectivity: to be able to look at how I am doing

Responsibility: to be accountable to my own and other's learning/resources

Reasoning: to be able to think about things in a different, more sensible way
