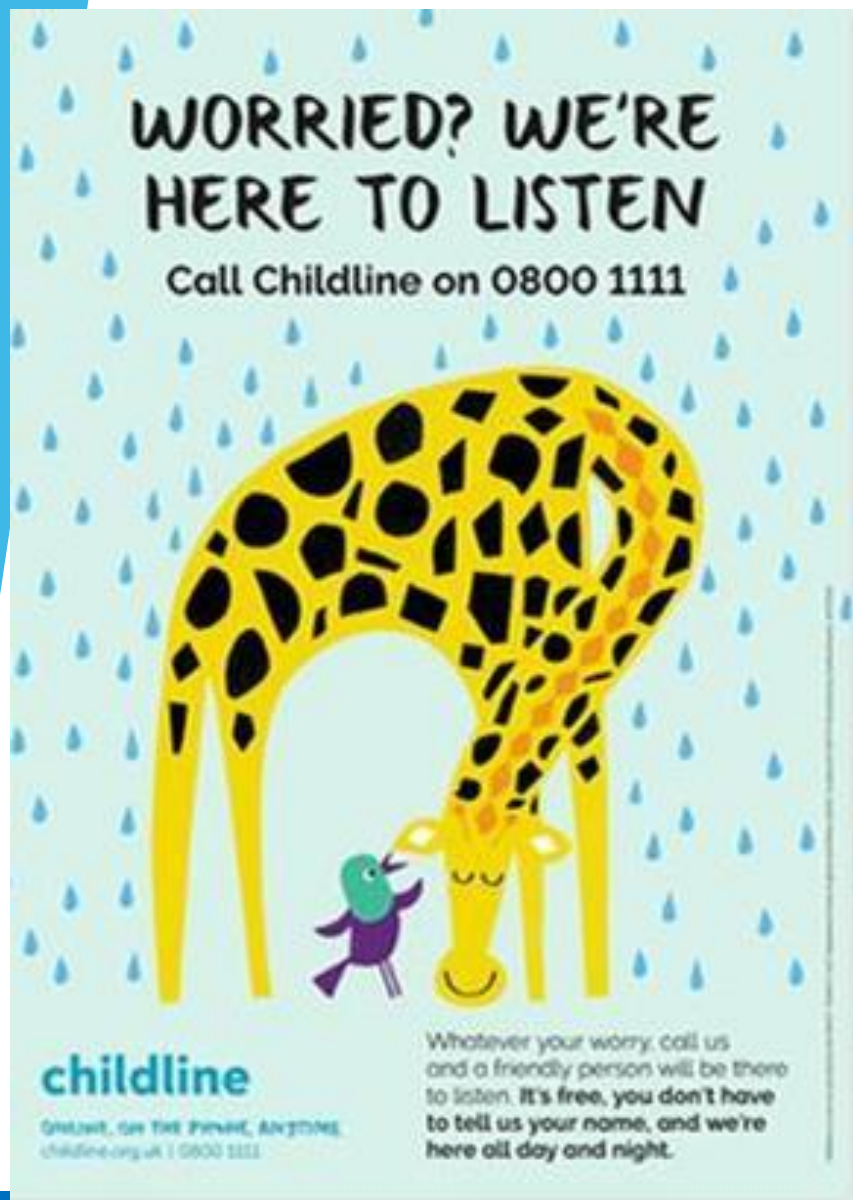

Come and find me anytime to talk about anything.

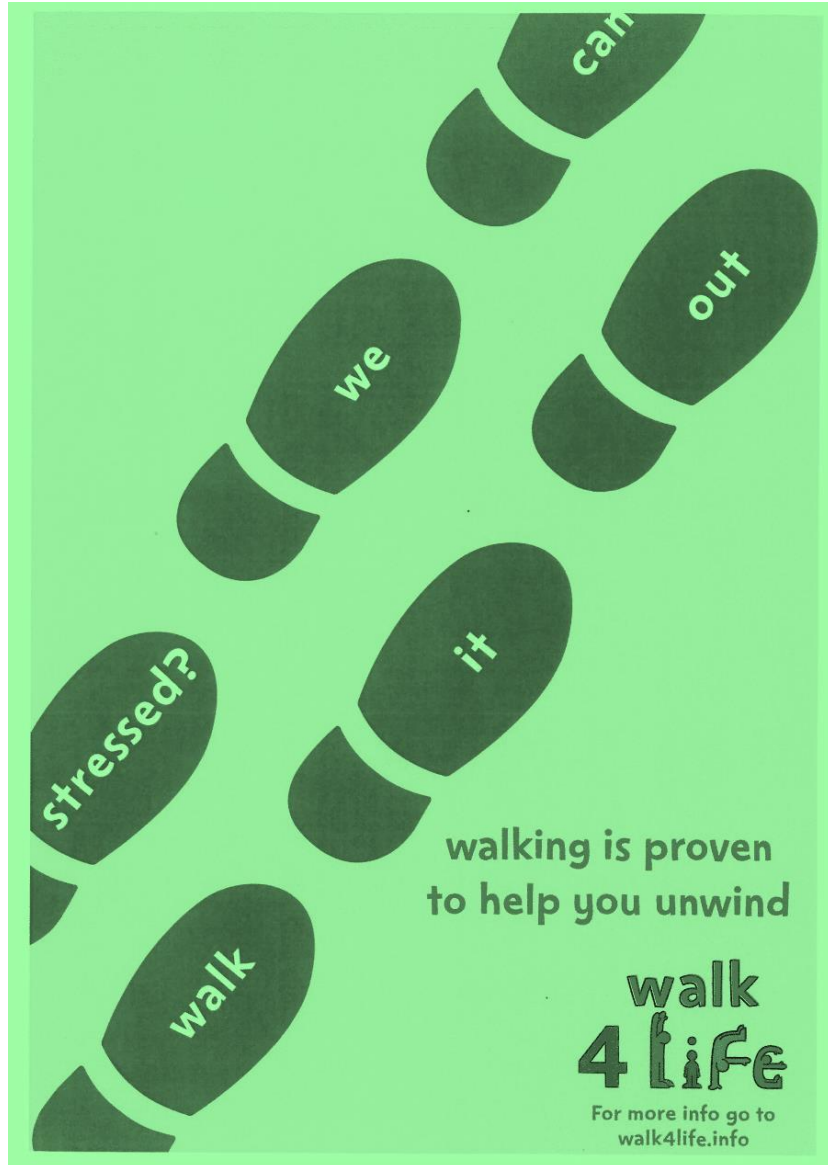
I will listen to any of your problems about home or school.
